



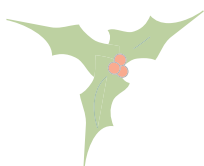

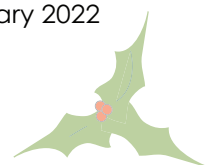

TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER
(No 04) 2021

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 04) 2021*.

Easement taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easements described in Schedule 2 are taken by Mackay Regional Council for drainage purposes and vests in Mackay Regional Council on and from 19 November 2021.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by each easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. TAKING OF THE EASEMENT

Mackay Regional Council (the "Council") takes the full and free right and liberty of using the Easement Area for flood mitigation, stormwater, drainage and levee purposes and to exercise all powers, authorities and discretions vested in it by law for the passage or conveyance of storm water and overland flow.

2. COUNCIL'S RIGHTS

2.1 The Council has the right at all reasonable times, upon giving prior written notice to the Owner (except in the case of an emergency when no notice will be required) with or without vehicles, machinery, plant and equipment and materials, to enter upon the Easement Area to pass and repass along the same at all times for the purposes of using and repairing the Works and in so doing the Council's Employees may:

- (1) remove and replace the Works with new Works;
- (2) change the size and number of any pipes forming part of the Works;
- (3) extend, deepen, widen, repair, renew, mow, cleanse, add to, inspect and maintain the Works including altering, replacing, relaying or changing the size, shape or type;
- (4) dig into, sink shafts into and open and break up the soil of the Easement Area;
- (5) remove and dispose of soil created as a consequence of the Council exercising its rights under this Easement;
- (6) do such other Works and things on or under the Easement Area as are incidental to the exercise of the Council's rights under this Easement;
- (7) take down any fencing or structure erected on the Easement Area.

2.2 In exercising its rights under this Easement the Council and the Council's Employees will subject to Clause 3:

- (1) exercise the rights in a proper and workmanlike manner so as to cause as little inconvenience and disruption as possible to the Owner's Land;
- (2) repair any damage it may cause to the surface of the Easement Area or adjoining land.

2.3 In the event that the levee constructed upon the Easement Area is damaged or destroyed by flood or other natural event then the Council shall be obliged to reinstate the Easement Area and the levee to at least the condition prior to damage or destructions as soon as practicable after the damaging event.

3. OWNER'S OBLIGATIONS

3.1 The Owner must not without the prior written consent of the Council:

- (1) construct or allow to be constructed upon the Easement Area any buildings or structures;
- (2) permit the Easement Area to be used in such a way as to obstruct or interfere with the Works and/or the proper and effective use of the Works by the Council;
- (3) install or have installed any concrete or bitumen paths or driveways on the Easement Area or gardens or landscaping using brick, concrete or other permanent materials;
- (4) alter the surface level of the Easement Area;

(5) obstruct, interrupt, impede, impair, or interfere with or divert the flow of storm water drainage along the Easement Area and will not change or alter anything done by the Council in terms hereof.

3.2 If the Owner wishes to construct upon the Easement Area any building or structure it will provide the Council with detailed plans enabling the Council to consider the request and the Council may in its absolute discretion refuse such request.

3.3 If the Council consents to the construction of a building or structure upon the Easement Area, the Owner:

- (a) will ensure that the building or structure is built in a proper and tradesmanlike manner in accordance with the plans submitted to the Council and will be maintained so as not to interfere with the Works;
- (b) acknowledges and accepts that the building or structure will be built upon the Easement Area at the sole risk of the Owner and will be used and occupied at the sole risk of the Owner;
- (c) acknowledges and accepts that it may be necessary for the Council to:
 - (i) demolish the whole or part of the said building or structure;
 - (ii) carry out work under or upon the surface of the Easement Area which may have an adverse impact upon the said building or structure or interfere with the use and enjoyment of the said building or structure or the land;
- (d) acknowledges and accepts that it cannot make any claim for compensation whatsoever arising from the Council exercising its rights under this easement or at law;
- (e) the Council's consent to erection of the said building or structure on the Easement Area shall not be deemed in any way an assumption by the Council of any obligation towards the Owner or to any person on the Easement Area and the Council shall not be thereby deemed to incur any liability;
- (f) indemnifies and will keep indemnified the Council against all actions, demands, claims, costs arising in any manner whatsoever from the construction, erection, use or occupation of the said building or structure upon the Easement Area.

4. PROPERTY IN WORKS

4.1 The Works remain the property of the Council despite being fixed to the Easement Area which is not inconsistent with the Council's rights under this Easement.

5. GENERAL

5.1 NOTICES

- (1) Any notice under this Easement must be in writing; and
- (2) Either party may serve a notice to the other party by:
 - (a) giving it to that party personally;
 - (b) posting it to the last known address of that party;
 - (c) sending it to the party's email address.
- (3) When served by post a Notice will be deemed to have been received on the third business day after posting.
- (4) When served by email a Notice will be deemed to have received if no electronic error notification is received by the sender, the date and time the email indicates it was sent.

5.2 RISK

The Council uses the Easement Area and exercises its rights under this Easement at its own risk.

5.3 COSTS

The council will pay:

- (1) The Owner's legal costs up to a maximum of \$1,100 (including GST) in relation to the preparation, negotiation and execution of the easement; and
- (2) Any transfer duty, reasonable mortgagee consent fee (if any) and registration fees and the costs of the preparation

of any survey plan necessary to effect registration of this Easement.

5.4 NO WAIVER

No condition in this Easement will be deemed to have been waived by the Owner or Council unless the waiver is in writing and signed on behalf of the Owner or Council, as the case may be. Any waiver shall not affect or prejudice rights or remedies in respect of any future or former breach and (unless expressly stated) shall not amount to a general waiver.

5.5 SEVERABILITY

If a provision contained in this Easement is invalid or unenforceable, that provision will, as far as possible, be read down to the extent necessary for it to be valid or enforceable but, if it cannot be read down, it will be severed from the document and the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect.

5.6 LAND TITLE ACT

For the purpose of Division 4 (Easements) of the *Land Title Act 1994*:

- (a) the Council is a public utility provider; and
- (b) this Easement is acquired for the purpose of a public utility service.

6. PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

6.1 The Council must effect a public liability insurance policy for an amount of not less than twenty million dollars (\$20 000 000.00), covering legal liability of any loss of or damage to any property and for the injury (including death) to any person arising out of anything done to or omitted on or about the Easement and against all claims, demands, proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance policy.

6.2 Clauses 6.1 will be satisfied if the Council is the State of Queensland or a statutory authority eligible for cover under the Queensland Government Insurance Fund and is insured and continues to be insured by the Queensland Government Insurance Fund.

6.3 The Council must, as soon as practicable, inform the Owner, in writing, of the occurrence of any event that the Council considers is likely to give rise to a claim under the policy of insurance effected and must ensure that the Owner are kept fully informed of subsequent actions and developments concerning the claim.

6.4 To remove any doubt, the requirements of this Clause 6 apply to any other area of the land used by the Council.

7. CONSTRUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

7.1 DEFINITIONS

- (1) **“Council”** means the Mackay Regional Council and its successors and assigns;
- (2) **“Council’s Employee’s”** means each of the Council’s employees, contractors or other persons authorised by the Council;
- (3) **“Owner”** means the Owner and includes:
 - (a) the executors, administrators and assigns of the Grantor and each of them;
 - (b) the registered owner for the time being of the Easement Area and the land of which it forms part from time to time.
- (4) **“Easement Area”** includes any part of the Easement Area.
- (5) **“Work”** means:
 - (a) levee, open earth drains, pipes, mains, earth fill embankments or other drainage to prevent and mitigate the effects of flood together with all other usual and necessary fittings and attachments for the purpose of conveying storm water/overland flow under or over the Easement Area; and/or
 - (b) works for the protection and/or support of each of those things.

7.2 CONSTRUCTION

(1) Reference to:

- (a) person includes a corporation and governmental body and

the legal representative, successors and assigns of that person;

- (b) a right includes a remedy, authority or power;
 - (c) a gender includes all genders;
 - (d) the singular includes the plural and the plural includes the singular.
- (2) Headings are for convenience only and do not effect the interpretation or form party of this Easement.

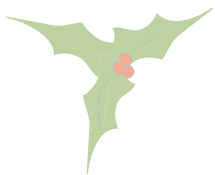

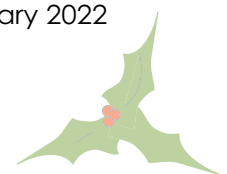
