Evaluation framework

The safe night precinct (SNP) evaluation framework guides the review of each SNP every three years. It considers:





INPUTS INCLUDING:

- Laws
- Funding and resources
- Governance
- Monitoring and reporting



ACTIVITIES INCLUDING:

- Monitoring venues
- Connecting licensees, government and community
- Providing public safety resources and support services for at risk people



- Compliance inspections
- SNP bans
- Local harm minimisation initiatives
- Support for people needing assistance
- Monitoring patron activity



- People feel safe in SNPs at night
- Disruptive people are deterred
- Highly visible services focused on minimising harm are provided
- Venues are compliant with legislative obligations
- SNP boundaries are located in the right areas



- SNPs contribute to a sustained vibrant night time economy with less risk of harm
- Less disturbances and public disorder incidents related to alcohol or drug use in SNPs
