The Local Government Change Commission (Change Commission) has assessed a proposed change to the external boundary between the Livingstone Shire Council and Rockhampton Regional Council to transfer the suburbs of Glenlee, Rockyview and Glendale from Livingstone Shire Council to the Rockhampton Regional Council.

After assessing the proposed change, the Change Commission has recommended the suburbs remain in the Livingstone Shire Council.


