

- (d) There is full and documented compliance with the provisions in the documents listed in paragraph (c) relating to:
 - i. Training and assessment of junior competitors;
 - ii. Separate and specific race briefings for junior competitors;
 - iii. The course size is reduced to be run only on one side of the Barcaldine Recreational Park waterway:
 - iv. The junior course has a designated safety corridor through the centre line of at least 20 metres;
 - v. Each junior event is limited to 4 ships at any one time;
