Part 1 - Introduction

1. Purpose of the guideline

This safe movement guideline exempts eligible light vehicles from Safety Certificate requirements for registration transactions in Queensland.

2. Authority

This safe movement guideline is issued under section 53 of the *Transport Operations* (*Road Use Management—Vehicle Standards and Safety*) *Regulation 2021* (the VSS Regulation).

3. Definitions

Unless otherwise stated, words and expressions used in the guideline have the same meanings as those defined in the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act* 1995 or the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Vehicle Standards and Safety) Regulation 2021.*

Part 2 - Requirements

1. Exemptions to vehicle standards

Eligible light vehicles are exempt from complying with Safety Certificate requirements prescribed under section 75(1) of the VSS Regulation until 1 July 2026.

2. Eligible light vehicles

An eligible light vehicle is a light vehicle where:

- the owner lives in the Weipa Town Authority area; and
- the vehicle is disposed of in Weipa Town Authority area; or
- the vehicle is disposed of in an exempt area as defined in Schedule 2 of the VSS Regulation.
