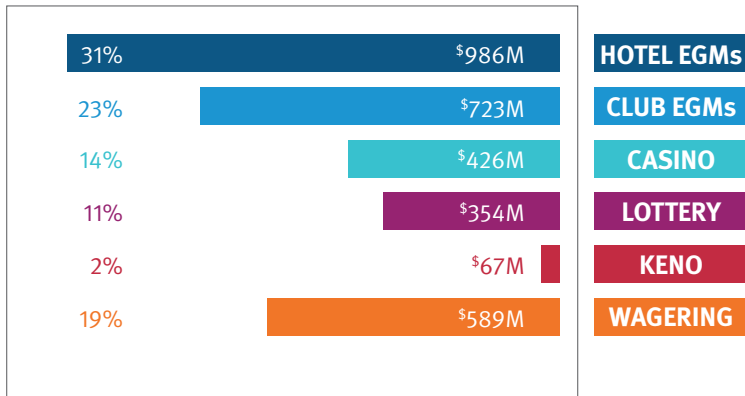

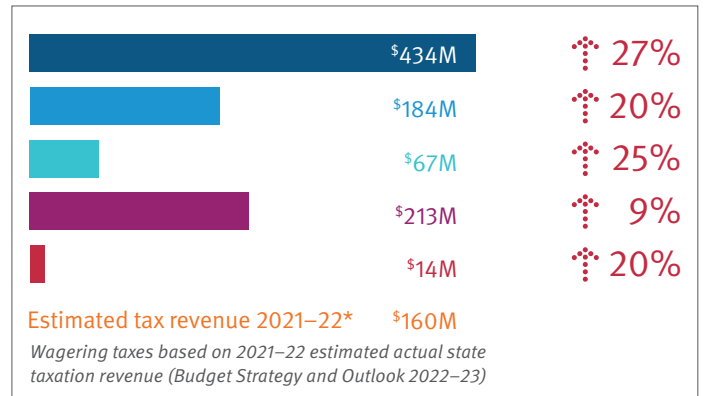

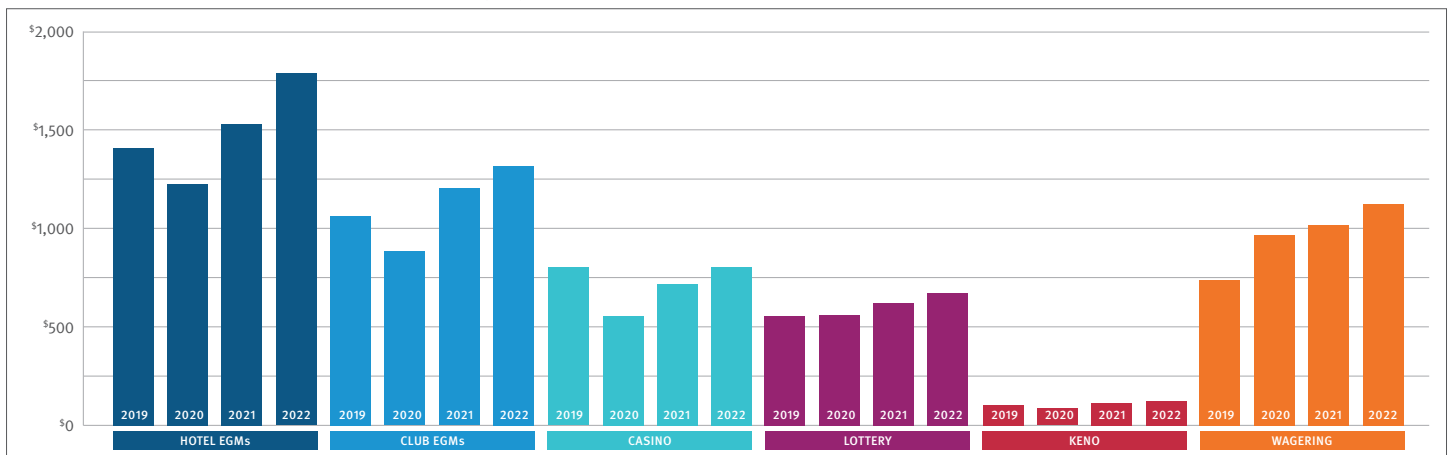


ESTIMATED TAX REVENUE (JUL-DEC 2022)



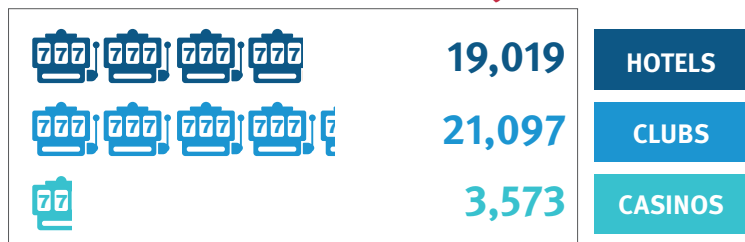

GAMBLING EXPENDITURE BY CALENDAR YEAR (\$M)



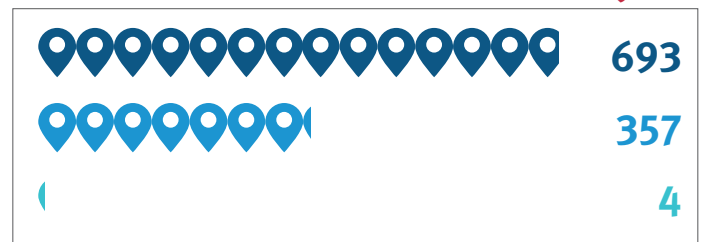

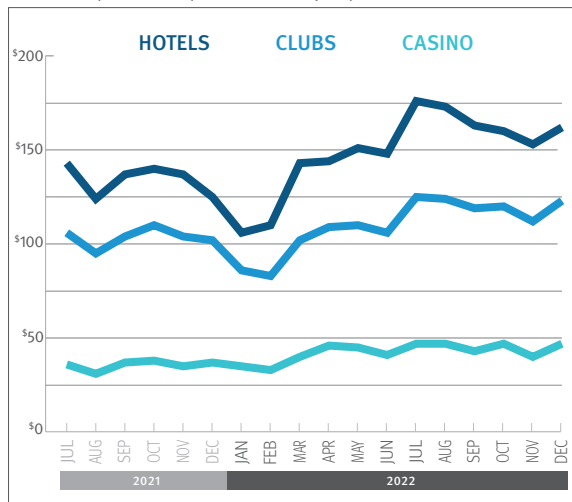

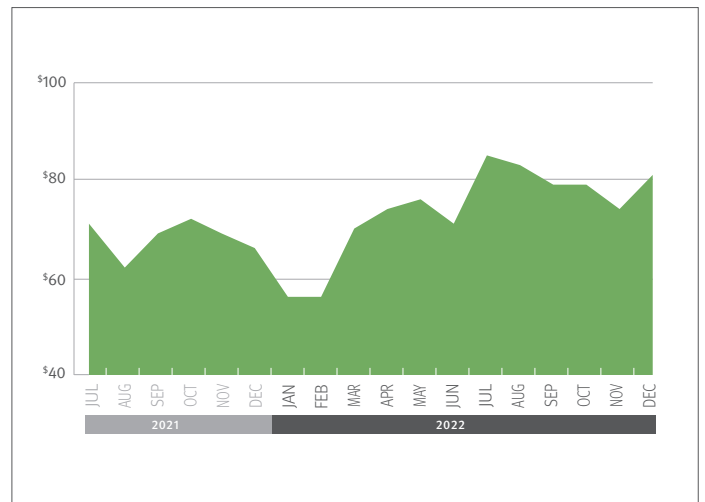
