



At its council meeting on 14 March 2017, Central Highlands Regional Council adopted *Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/16 – Operational Work within a flood hazard area* in accordance with section 117 of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*.

This temporary local planning instrument applies to all areas identified in the Flood Hazard Overlay on planning scheme maps OM005a – OM005i. The temporary local planning instrument will commence on 31 March 2017 and will cease to have effect on 30 March 2018.

The temporary local planning instrument is intended to address the significant risk of unmanaged filling and excavating in areas affected by flooding from resulting in adverse impacts as a result of a reduction in flood storage and changes to flows, velocities or levels for flood events.


