## Recreational fishing on a commercial fishing operation

The following requirements are in place to ensure the sustainability of fish species and ensure extra catch is not being landed and sold illegally.

You can only fish recreationally on a commercial fishing trip if the fisheries quota status and fishery symbols on your primary commercial fishing licence permit it.

## Recreational catch:

- must not be sold
- must be caught using permitted recreational fishing gear
- must comply with relevant size, possession and form limits.

The table below identifies when recreationally caught fish can be taken on a commercial fishing operation's vessel and the relevant reporting requirements.
