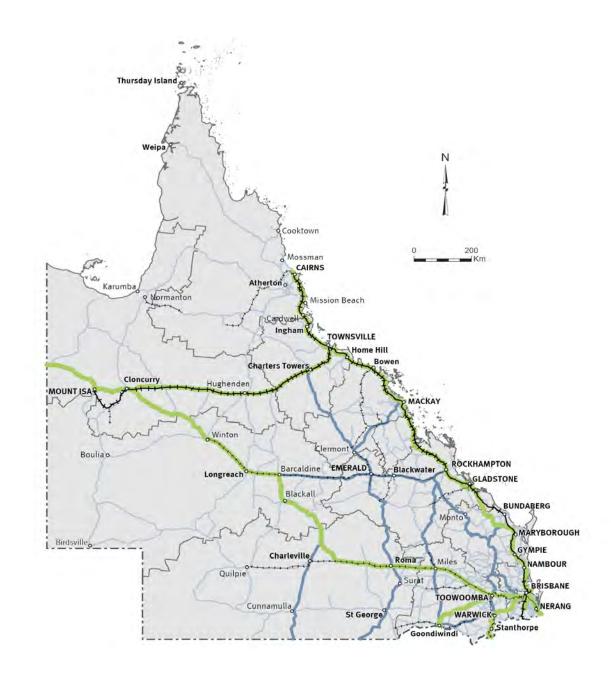

# Program highlights

- \$4.869 billion Queensland Train Manufacturing Program
- \$2.598 billion towards Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail (jointly funded with the Australian Government)
- \$1 billion funding commitment for the Inland Freight Route, Charters Towers to Mungindi (jointly funded with the Australian Government). Project details and timing subject to further planning and negotiation with Australian Government.
- \$585.2 million funding commitment for the Warrego Highway (jointly funded with the Australian Government). Project details and timing subject to further planning and negotiation with the Australian Government, noting the Queensland Government's initial priority is upgrading the Mount Crosby Road interchange.
- \$511.5 million funding commitment for Road Safety Program (jointly funded with the Australian Government). Project details and timing subject to further planning and negotiation with the Australian Government.
- \$500 million funding commitment for Queensland Beef Corridors (jointly funded with the Australian Government).
