



# **Mackay/Whitsunday**

#### **Overview**

The Mackay/Whitsunday District covers an area of about 90,362km², or around 5.2% of Queensland¹. It extends from north of Bowen to south of St Lawrence, and west to Clermont and the Bowen Basin.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 182,303 or around 3.8% of Queensland's total population<sup>1</sup>.

The district looks after about 2,221km of other state-controlled roads and 451km of the National Land Transport Network.

## District program highlights

In 2016-17 we completed:

- Design of the Mackay Ring Road Stage 1 project, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Construction of a dual-lane roundabout on the Bruce Highway, at the Hay Point Road intersection, funded by the Australian Government.
- Construction of overtaking lanes near Thomsetts Road on the Bruce Highway, between Mackay and Proserpine, funded by the Australian Government.

- Construction of overtaking lanes near Kitty Creek and Carey Creek on the Bruce Highway, between Calen and Kuttabul, funded by the Australian Government.
- Construction of overtaking lanes near Dingo Creek and Emu Creek on the Bruce Highway, between Proserpine and Bowen, funded by the Australian Government.
- Pavement widening works at various locations on the Gregory Highway, 10km south of Clermont, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

#### In 2017-18 we will:

- Continue preliminary design of the Walkerston Bypass, on the Peak Downs Highway west of Mackay, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Continue replacing two bridges at Vines Creek, on Mackay-Slade Point Road.
- Continue upgrading the Peak Downs Highway at Eton Range, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Oueensland Government.
- Replace the existing Sandy Gully Bridge and approaches on the Bruce Highway near Bowen, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Continue replacing four timber bridges on the Peak Downs Highway at Fiery Creek, Lonely Creek, Boundary Creek and Cut Creek, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Oueensland Government.
- Commence construction of the Mackay Ring Road Stage 1 project, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Oueensland Government.

- Commence design for pavement widening on sections of the Peak Downs Highway, between Wuthung Road and Caval Ridge, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Commence design for progressive paving and rehabilitation of the Bowen Developmental Road, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Complete design of duplication, from four to six lanes, on the Bruce Highway, as part of the Mackay Northern Access, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Complete design of the Sarina Northern Access
  Upgrade, jointly funded by the Australian Government
  and Queensland Government.
- Complete intersection improvements on the Bruce Highway at Lower Don Road, funded by the Australian Government.


## **Future plans**

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Mackay/Whitsunday District.

In 2017-18 we will:

- Continue planning for the duplication of the Bruce Highway between Hay Point Road and Temples Lane.
- Continue planning for the replacement of Miclere Bridge, on the Gregory Developmental Road.
- Continue flood investigations on Proserpine-Shute Harbour Road, at Hamilton Plains.




