

Far North

Overview

The Far North District covers an area of about 273,158km², or around 15.8% of Queensland¹. It extends from the Torres Strait Islands in the north to the top of the Cardwell Range in the south, and from Cairns in the east to Croydon in the west.

The district has an estimated residential population of about 277,305 or around 5.8% of Queensland's total population¹.

The district looks after about 2,941km of other state-controlled road and about 217km of the National Land Transport Network.

District program highlights

In 2016-17 we completed:

- Widening and sealing of various sections of the Gulf Developmental Road, between Croydon and Georgetown.
- Formation widening and wide-centre line treatment on sections of the Bruce Highway, between Tully and Innisfail, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Oueensland Government.

- Sealing sections of the Peninsula Developmental Road at Musgrave, and between Little Laura River and Fairview Station, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Construction of overtaking lanes on the Kennedy Highway, at Koah.
- Construction of a northbound overtaking lane on the Bruce Highway, south of Gordonvale, funded by the Australian Government.
- Sealing works on the Endeavour Valley Road near Hope Vale, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Paving and sealing works on Malanda-Upper Barron Road, near Malanda.
- A package of works to improve safety at priority intersections on the Atherton Tablelands.
- Boat ramp works at Bellenden Ker, Packers Camp and Cowley Beach, and replacement of fender piles on two jetties in Innisfail.
- The business case for the Smithfield Transport Corridor Upgrade project in partnership with Building Queensland.

In 2017-18 we will:

- Complete the duplication of the Bill Fulton Bridge on the Cairns Western Arterial Road.
- Complete planning for duplication of the Bruce Highway (Innisfail - Cairns), Cairns Southern Access Corridor Stage 3 – Edmonton to Gordonvale, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

- Complete installation of variable message signs on the Kuranda Range Road section of the Kennedy Highway.
- Commence widening and sealing works on the Burke Developmental Road between Chillagoe and Almaden, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Complete bridge strengthening works on Gulf Developmental Road and Mulligan Highway.
- Continue a package of works to improve safety at priority intersections on the Atherton Tablelands.
- Complete the six-laning extension of the Bruce Highway (Innisfail – Cairns), Cairns Southern Access Corridor Stage 2 – Robert Road to Foster Road, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Construct a floating walkway at the Edmonton boat ramp, and reconstruct the Fearnley Street boat ramp to an all tide standard and construct a floating walkway.
- Complete paving and sealing a section of the Peninsula Developmental Road, Coen South.
- Complete paving and sealing a section of the Peninsula Developmental Road, Archer to Wolverton.
- Continue to pave and seal a section of the Peninsula Developmental Road (Laura Race Course to Little Laura, 10 Mile Creek, South of Duck Holes Creek and Myall Creek to Rio Boundary), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Complete pavement widening on sections of the Bruce Highway (Innisfail to Cairns), jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.

Future plans

We are continuing to plan for the future transport requirements of residents in the Far North District.

In 2017-18 we plan to:

- Complete planning for the future six-laning of the Bruce Highway (Innisfail - Cairns), Cairns Southern Access Corridor Stage 4 – Kate Street and Aumuller Street, jointly funded by the Australian Government and Queensland Government.
- Continue planning to complete the bitumen sealing and upgrade infrastructure on the Peninsula Developmental Road, between Laura and Weipa.
- Continue planning for the Mulligan Highway Northern Mareeba Bypass.
- Commence planning on Dallachy Road flood immunity project.
- Commence planning for the Bruce Highway Innisfail Bypass plan and preserve the corridor.
- Commence planning for the Bruce Highway intersection upgrade at Babinda.


