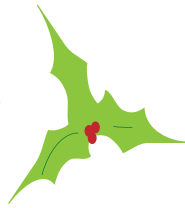

A meeting fee of \$1,989 is payable for attendance at each of the mandated monthly meetings of Council subject to certification by the Mayor or Chief Executive Officer of the Council. Mayors and Deputy Mayors in Category 3 receive the full remuneration.

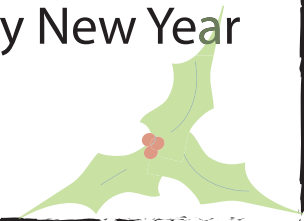

 - *Tourism Queensland Employing Office Certified Agreement 2009 (CA/2009/95)* and;
- who are employed in the employing entities listed in Schedule 1 as at, or after, date of gazettal of this Directive.

DIRECTIVE**5. Increase to salary**

5.1. Employees who are covered by this directive are entitled to the following salary increases:
