## COMPLAINT

## 1. has threatened:

- (a) to assault or to do any bodily injury to the complainant or to any person under the care or charge of the complainant
- (b) to procure any other person to assault or to do any bodily injury to the complainant or to any person under the care or charge of the complainant
- (c) to destroy or damage any property of the complainant
- (d) to procure any other person to destroy or damage any property of the complainant

and the complainant is in fear of the person complained against namely LANCE BOYLE **OR** 

2. **that the intentional conduct of (the defendant)** directed at the complainant has caused the complainant to fear that the defendant will destroy or damage any property of the complainant.

The grounds of the complaint are:

I work at XXX Suppliers and Manufacturers in West End, where I am the assistant manager.

I have known Mr Boyle for about four years and we worked together at XXX Suppliers and Manufacturers during that time. We were both Team Leaders. In November 2011 there was a vacancy advertised for the assistant manager of the business. Mr Boyle and I both applied for this role and I was the successful applicant and was duly promoted. Mr Boyle believed he was the best person for the job and told me several times. I was appointed and began working as the assistant manager as of 25<sup>th</sup> November 2011. On the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2011 Mr Boyle submitted his resignation from the company.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> November 2011 I was walking to my car and noticed that someone was standing near the car, when I got closer I realised that the person was Mr Boyle. When he saw me he walked up to me quickly and I noticed he looked very agitated and was yelling and screaming "You are a thief and a back stabber. I will punch your head in. You stole the job that was meant to be mine! I was the best person for the job and you know it." He then ran away down the street. I was a bit shaken and I have seen him cranky like this before when things at work have upset him. I then went home. I did not say anything to anyone at work about this.

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2011 when I was walking to my car he was standing beside my car. This time he told me that I had better watch out and that he would get a metal bar and do some serious damage to my car and also to my face. He then walked away. He knows where I live.

Because of these events I am fearful that he will carry out these threats. I am worried that he will continue to harass me.
