<b>Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required</b>	<p>The objective of the Proclamation is to fix 2 June 2025 as the commencement date for the remaining provisions of the Promoting Safety Act. These provisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>strengthen powers to respond to abuse of prisoner communication channels (sections 40, 41, 45 and 46),</li> <li>enable the use of certain police powers for reportable child sex offenders being supervised under the <i>Dangerous Prisoners (Sexual Offenders) Act 2003</i> (sections 49, 50, 51, 56 and 57),</li> <li>clarify the limits of the chief executive's authorisation to use a prescribed surveillance device at a corrective services facility (section 42),</li> <li>clarify the authority for corrective services officers to use body-worn cameras while in the community (43), and</li> <li>confirm arrangements for corrective services officers supporting proper officers of courts (section 44).</li> </ul> <p>The Proclamation is required to allow these provisions to commence concurrently with sections 19 and 35 of the <i>Corrective Services (Emerging Technologies and Security) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2023</i>.</p> <p>The proposal relates to police powers and administration, general criminal laws, the administration of courts and tribunals and corrective services. No regulatory impact analysis is required under the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>.</p>
