Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	The objective of the Proclamation is to fix 2 June 2025 as the commencement date for the remaining provisions of the Promoting Safety Act. These provisions:
	• strengthen powers to respond to abuse of prisoner communication channels (sections 40, 41, 45 and 46),
	enable the use of certain police powers for reportable child sex offenders being supervised under the <i>Dangerous Prisoners (Sexual Offenders) Act 2003</i> (sections 49, 50, 51, 56 and 57),
	<ul> <li>clarify the limits of the chief executive's authorisation to use a prescribed surveillance device at a corrective services facility (section 42),</li> </ul>
	clarify the authority for corrective services officers to use body-worn cameras while in the community (43), and
	confirm arrangements for corrective services officers supporting proper officers of courts (section 44).
	The Proclamation is required to allow these provisions to commence concurrently with sections 19 and 35 of the Corrective Services (Emerging Technologies and Security) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2023.
	The proposal relates to police powers and administration, general criminal laws, the administration of courts and tribunals and corrective services. No regulatory impact analysis is required under the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i> .
