Applications not lodged 21 days in advance will not be processed.</p> <p>To apply for an one-off extended hours permit to trade between midnight and 5:00am the Commissioner must be satisfied it is for a special occasion.</p> <p>Please note that the Commissioner must also be satisfied that the one-off extended hours permit is for:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Persons, independent of the licensee, owner or occupier of the licensed premises wishing to celebrate the special occasion on the licensed premises. 2. The time that the special occasion is happening and a reasonable time before and after the special occasion. <p>Definition of special occasion and special public event:</p> <p>special occasion means—</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) the occasion of a special public event; or (b) a wedding, birthday or other private occasion being celebrated at a function that is not open to the public. <p>special public event—</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) means a unique or infrequent event of local, State or national significance; and Examples— a local music festival happening over a weekend a televised international sporting match involving an Australian team (b) includes an event prescribed by regulation, or of a class of events prescribed by regulation, to be a special public event; and (c) does not include an event prescribed by regulation, or of a class of events prescribed by regulation, not to be a special public event.
