

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 14 June 2023

Area: South East Queensland
Locality: Chichester Canal, Raby Bay
Activity: Construction Barge Activities

Mariners are advised that:

Construction barge activities and harbour works will be undertaken to perform wall and batter remediation works in the Chichester Canal, Raby Bay in the approximate position latitude 27°31.063'S, longitude 153°16.073'E.

Pontoon removal will commence on Tuesday 20/06/2023. Construction activities will commence on Tuesday 27/06/2023 and are expected to be completed by December 2023.

The works are to be undertaken during daylight hours between 0600 and 1800. The outer boundary of the work site will be marked with yellow buoys. Construction barges and support vessels will display appropriate day shapes and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 16 at all times.

At the completion of works each day, yellow flashing lights will be displayed during hours of darkness and fitted to the extremities of all work vessels, the outer boundary of the worksite, stockpiles and relocated pontoons. All anchored vessels will display appropriate lighting.

Mariners should navigate with caution when transiting the area
