Issued by Brisbane Maritime Region on 26 June 2025

Area: South East Queensland
Locality: Redland Bay ferry terminal
Activity: commencement of piling operations

Mariners are advised that:

Pile replacement works will commence in the vicinity of Redland Bay ferry terminal in approximate position latitude 27°36.920'E, longitude 153° 18.601'S from Thursday 3 July 2025. Works will be conducted between 0630 hours and 1700 hours Monday to Friday. Barge AQUILA and associated vessels will remain onsite for the duration of the work. Works are scheduled to be completed by Friday 18 July 2025.

Work vessels can be contacted on VHF channel 13 and VHF channel 16.

Mariners should navigate with caution, maintain a safe distance off and operate at reduced speed with minimal wash in the vicinity of these works.

Latitude and longitude positions are on WGS84 horizontal datum and are compatible with GDA2020 datum.
