### Acquisition of Land Act 1967

# TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE (No 03) 2022

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice* (No 03) 2022

#### Easement taken [ss.6 and 9(6) of the Act]

**2.** The easement described in Schedule 2 is taken by Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority trading as Urban Utilities for sewerage (volumetric) purposes and vests in Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority trading as Urban Utilities on and from 9 December 2022.

## Rights and obligations

**3.** That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by the easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

### **SCHEDULE 1**

## 1. Definitions and references

## 1.1 Definitions

In this easement:

**Authorised Persons** means employees, agents and contractors of, and other persons authorised, by Urban Utilities.

Easement Area means that part of the Land over which this easement is taken

Land means the parcel of the Owner's land that includes the Easement Area.

**Owner** means any person who has an estate, interest, right, power or privilege in, over, or in relation to the land subject to the Easement Area and that person's administrators, assignees and successors.

**Sewerage Works** means all pipes for carrying, treating or disposing of sewage and other wastewater, all ancillary plant, equipment, fittings and attachments (including pumps and pump stations) and works of any nature to protect or support any of them.

## Urban Utilities means:

- (a) the Central SEQ Distributor-Retailer Authority (trading as Urban Utilities), established under section 8 of the South-East Queensland Water (Distribution and Retail Restructuring) Act 2009 and its assignees and successors; and
- (b) if the context permits, Authorised Persons.

### 1.2 References to things on Easement Area

In this easement, and unless the context indicates a contrary intention, a reference to a thing on, or the doing of anything on or in respect of, land in the Easement Area includes a reference to a thing, or the doing of the thing, in or through the land in the Easement Area.

## 2. Urban Utilities' rights

Urban Utilities has the following rights under this easement:

(a) to transmit, or permit to be transmitted sewage and other

- wastewater in and through Sewerage Works on the Easement Area:
- (b) to construct, place, lay, deepen, widen, inspect, clean, maintain, change, add to, remove, repair, replace, relay, renew, use and manage the Sewerage Works on the Easement Area at all times and from time to time;
- (c) to do anything to remedy or prevent any infringement of its rights under this easement by an Owner or to enforce any obligation of an Owner under this easement, at the relevant Owner's cost; and
- (d) in order to exercise the rights in clauses 2 (a) to (c):
  - (i) enter the Easement Area, remain within it, and pass and repass within it, with or without machinery, plant, equipment, tools and materials;
  - (ii) place on the Easement Area the machinery, plant, equipment, tools and materials required to exercise those rights and leave them there;
  - (iii) excavate through the Easement Area using trenchless methodologies;
  - (iv) remove and dispose of spoil created by the exercise of those rights; and
  - (v) do anything else on the Easement Area that Urban Utilities considers reasonably necessary to exercise those rights.

## 3. Owner's obligations

An Owner must:

- a) allow the Sewerage Works to remain on the Easement Area;
- not, unless it has Urban Utilities' prior written consent:
  - (i) erect, install or lay any structure or other thing on the Easement Area;
  - (ii) remove soil, sand, gravel or any other substance or material from the Easement Area; or
  - (iii) do or cause or permit anything (including granting rights to another person) in connection with the Easement Area that could obstruct, interfere with or damage the Sewerage Works or their proper and effective use or the proper exercise of Urban Utilities' rights under this easement.

## 4. Property in Sewerage Works

The Sewerage Works are Urban Utilities' property and do not become an Owner's property.

## 5. Exercise of Urban Utilities' rights

- (a) In exercising Urban Utilities' rights under this easement, Urban Utilities must, at its own cost:
  - (i) ensure all work is done in a proper and workmanlike manner; and
- (ii) comply with all relevant laws.
- (b) This easement does not affect any rights or powers Urban

Utilities may have under a statute, including the Water Supply (Safety and Reliability) Act 2008 and the South-East Queensland Water (Distribution and Retail Restructuring) Act 2009.

### Notes to the remuneration schedule

In its 2014 report the then Tribunal explained the rationale behind the adoption of a system of remuneration which comprised a base payment (of two thirds of the annual remuneration) and a monthly payment based upon attendance at, and participation in, the 12 mandated council meetings.

- **Note 1** The monetary amounts shown are the per annum figures to apply from 1 July 2023. If an elected representative only serves for part of a full financial year (that is, 1 July to 30 June) they are only entitled to a pro rata payment to reflect the portion of the year served.
- Note 2 For councillors in category 1 councils, a base payment of \$38,266.67 is payable for the 12 months commencing on 1 July 2023. A meeting fee of \$1,594.44 per calendar month (or fortnightly equivalent) is payable for attendance at, and participation in, scheduled meetings of council subject to certification by the mayor and/or chief executive officer of the council. Mayors and deputy mayors in category 1 councils are to receive the full annual remuneration level shown.
