Acquisition of Land Act 1967 TAKING OF EASEMENT NOTICE BY THE MINISTER (No 04) 2024

Short title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Taking of Easement Notice* by the Minister (No 04) 2024.

Easement taken [ss.6 and 9(7) of the Act]

2. The easements described in Schedule 2 are taken by Ipswich City Council for drainage purposes and vest in Ipswich City Council on and from 26 April 2024.

Rights and obligations

3. That the rights and obligations conferred and imposed by each easement include the matters set out in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

The Council holds an easement for the purposes, powers, rights and liberties set out below.

1. INTERPRETATION

1.1 In this easement:

"**Burdened Land**" means the servient tenement (burdened land) identified in the Taking of Easement Notice and includes a separate reference to each separately identifiable part of that land.

"**Constructing Authority**" means the constructing authority named in the Taking of Easement Notice and also includes any person to which the rights or interest under this easement of the Constructing Authority are transferred, or pass by operation of law, from time to time.

"Easement Purpose" means, if the purpose specified in the Taking of Easement Notice is drainage, the drainage, passing or conveying of water (including stormwater) from, to, under, through or across the Burdened Land through pipes, channels, overland flow or by any other means.

"Infrastructure" means:

- (a) any plant, equipment or things for draining, passing, conveying or regulating or directing the passage, flow, collection, detention or retention of water or for other drainage purposes; and
- (b) pipes, drains, surface manholes, vents, marker posts, plates and any plant, equipment or fittings connected with or appurtenant to any of those things or the things listed in paragraph (a) of this definition.

"Local Government Act" means the same thing as in the Local Government Act 2009. "Taking of Easement Notice" means the Taking of

"Taking of Easement Notice" means the Taking of Easement Notice by the Minister (No 00) 2024 published in the Government Gazette pursuant to the *Acquisition of Land Act 1967* (Qld).

"Registered Owner" means the Registered Owner of the Burdened Land, and also includes any person who becomes a registered owner of the Burdened Land, or who has an estate or interest in the Burdened Land, from time to time.

- 1.2 If the Registered Owner or the Constructing Authority consists of two or more persons at any time:
 - (a) a reference in this easement to that party is to be read as a reference to each of those persons individually, and each combination of them jointly; and
 - (b) those persons are bound and benefited by this easement both individually and in each combination of them jointly.
- 1.3 A reference in this easement to a person includes a reference to a body corporate, a local government and every other kind of legal person.
- 1.4 A reference in this easement to a provision or definition contained in a specific Act is taken:
 - (a) to refer to that provision or definition as amended, relocated, re-enacted or consolidated from time to time; and
 - (b) after the repeal of the provision or definition to continue to refer to that provision or definition as it stood just before its repeal and to also refer to any replacement provision or definition which most closely deals with the same or the most closely similar subject matter either in the same Act as the original provision or definition or, if that Act is repealed, in some other Act which replaced the repealed Act or deals with the same or most closely similar subject matter to the repealed Act; and
 - (c) in any case to import any other legislative provisions (such as the definitions of other terms defined in the Act which are used in the provision or definition referred to or taken to be referred to in this easement, and the provisions of any relevant Acts Interpretation Act as they apply in the interpretation of that provision or definition) which are relevant in the interpretation of the provision or definition referred to or taken to be referred to in this easement in the same way as those legislative provisions are imported in the interpretation of the provision or definition.
- 1.5 The headings in this easement are for reference purposes only and are not to be used in interpreting this easement.

2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 The Constructing Authority has acquired an easement over the Burdened Land for the purposes of:
 - (a) the Easement Purpose; and

- (b) the installation, maintenance and removal of Infrastructure on, in or under the Burdened Land; and
- (c) the exercise by the Constructing Authority of the other rights given to the Constructing Authority by this easement or which the Constructing Authority has authority to undertake or engage in under a Local Government Act.
- 2.2 The Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement in relation to the Burdened Land are not exclusive to the Constructing Authority. However, the Registered Owner must not grant any rights to any person in relation to the Burdened Land if the granting of those other rights could conflict or interfere with any of the Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement.

3. **RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF CONSTRUCTING AUTHORITY**

- 3.1 The Constructing Authority may:
 - (a) install, repair, remove, replace, clean, clear and alter any Infrastructure on, in or under the Burdened Land from time to time (and, for this purpose, break open the surface of the Burdened Land and dig into the surface of the Burdened Land); and
 - (b) inspect or survey the Burdened Land from time to time; and
 - (c) undertake mowing, slashing and vegetation control or removal on the Burdened Land from time to time; and
 - (d) enter the Burdened Land for the purpose of doing or getting ready to do any of those things; and
 - (e) pull down or break open any fencing on or adjacent to the Burdened Land in order to enter it (but only after giving reasonable prior notice to the Registered Owner if any livestock are contained within the fenced area); and
 - (f) take anything onto the Burdened Land (and any other land owned or occupied by the Registered Owner) when entering it and use and operate what has been taken onto the Burdened Land; and
 - (g) stockpile on the Burdened Land any Infrastructure or items for or relating to the installation or removal of Infrastructure by the Constructing Authority before or during the installation or after the removal of any Infrastructure by the Constructing Authority; and
 - (h) stockpile on the Burdened Land any soil or matter dug up on or from under the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority for a reasonable period; and
 - (i) temporarily restrict access to the Burdened Land or parts of it, by whatever means the Constructing Authority thinks fit including fencing off the Burdened Land or parts of it, and doing other things to provide for the security of Infrastructure of the Constructing Authority, items referred to in paragraph (g) or soil referred to in paragraph (h); and
 - (j) run and pass water, fluids and substances of any description to, from, through or about the Burdened Land or any Infrastructure installed by the Constructing Authority on the Burdened Land; and
 - (k) do anything the Constructing Authority reasonably requires to do in connection with or in order to exercise any of the powers listed above or to enjoy the benefit of this easement for the purposes specified in subclause 2.1.
- 3.2 If in exercising its rights and powers under this easement the Constructing Authority digs up any soil or matter from or from under the Burdened Land:
 - (a) the soil or matter becomes the property of the Constructing Authority; and
 - (b) the Constructing Authority has no obligation to compensate the Registered Owner; and
 - (c) the Constructing Authority must either stockpile the soil or matter as permitted by paragraph 3.l(h) or remove it from the Burdened Land at the Constructing Authority's own expense.
- 3.3 The Constructing Authority does not need to exercise its rights and powers under this easement personally. It may authorise other people to exercise those rights and powers.

- 3.4 In exercising its rights and powers under this easement, the Constructing Authority must:
 - (a) ensure that any work it does on the Burdened Land is done properly; and
 - (b) use reasonable endeavours to cause as little inconvenience as is reasonably practicable to the Registered Owner; and
 - (c) restore the Burdened Land as nearly as is reasonably practicable to its former condition if the Burdened Land is damaged by the Constructing Authority (other than in a manner authorised by this easement).
- 3.5 If the Constructing Authority permanently removes any Infrastructure that had been installed on, in or under the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority under this easement, the Constructing Authority must restore the Burdened Land as nearly as is reasonably practicable to its former condition before the installation of the infrastructure.
- 3.6 If the Registered Owner breaches this easement, the Constructing Authority may do anything the Constructing Authority thinks is reasonably necessary to correct the breach (such as removing a structure erected on the Burdened Land in breach of this easement).

4. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF REGISTERED OWNER

- 4.1 The Registered Owner must:
 - (a) not erect any building, structure, pipeline, road, fence, driveway or paving on the Burdened Land without the consent of the Constructing Authority; and
 - (b) not change or allow to fall into disrepair any building, structure, pipeline, road, fence, driveway or paving on the Burdened Land (other than removing one erected on the Burdened Land in breach of this easement); and
 - (c) not alter the ground level of the Burdened Land or change its topography; and
 - (d) not plant trees on the Burdened Land; and
 - (e) not crop, dig or plough the Burdened Land; and
 - (f) not act unreasonably in ensuring that any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time is not damaged; and
 - (g) not trespass on any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time; and
 - (h) not cause a nuisance that adversely affects the Constructing Authority's rights and powers under this easement or any Infrastructure installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time, and if any such nuisance arises, not delay in abating any such nuisance; and
 - (i) use the Registered Owner's best endeavours to prevent anyone else doing any of the things that the Registered Owner is required not to do under this easement and not allow anyone else to do any of those things.
- 4.2 The Registered Owner is taken to have the consent of the Constructing Authority to do a thing that would otherwise be in breach of paragraph 4.1(a) or 4.1(b) if:
 - a development approval which is current under the *Planning Act 2016* and which attaches to the Burdened Land authorises the Registered Owner to do that thing; and
 - (b) the development approval was given by the Constructing Authority as assessment manager under the *Planning Act 2016*; and
 - (c) the Registered Owner does that thing in accordance with the development approval.
- 4.3 The Registered Owner is responsible for the acts and omissions of anyone claiming through the Registered Owner (like tenants, licensees and mortgagees). An act or omission of any of those people is treated for the purposes of this easement as if it was an act or omission of the Registered Owner personally.
- 4.4 The Registered Owner and the Constructing Authority acknowledge and agree that the following covenant conditions the performance of any covenant made by the Constructing Authority:

- (a) The Registered Owner must indemnify and release the Constructing Authority from any claim, action, loss, expense, proceeding or liability by the Registered Owner or anyone else arising from:
 - i. the use or occupation of the Burdened Land; or
 - any act or omission of any person on or affecting the Burdened Land or in any way relating to the Burdened Land or the Infrastructure on it from time to time; or
 - iii. a breach by the Registered Owner of this easement; or
 - iv. the Registered Owner's negligence, except to the extent that the claim, action, loss, expense, proceeding or liability is a direct result of:
 - a. a breach by the Constructing Authority of this easement; or
 - b. the Constructing Authority's negligence.
- 4.5 The operation of section 85B(2) of the Land Title Act 1994 (Qld) in respect of this easement is expressly excluded. The Constructing Authority is under no liability, under section 85B(2) of the Land Title Act 1994 or otherwise, to contribute towards the cost of keeping the Burdened Land in a condition appropriate for enjoyment of this easement.
- 4.6 The Registered Owner must obtain the Constructing Authority's written approval before commencing any works on the Burdened Land and the Registered Owner is responsible for all damages and compensations if works are carried out on the Burdened Land without the Constructing Authority's written approval and/or not in accordance with the Constructing Authority's written approval.

5. OTHER MATTERS

- 5.1 All Infrastructure and other things brought onto or installed on the Burdened Land by the Constructing Authority from time to time will, as between the Registered Owner and the Constructing Authority, remain the property of the Constructing Authority.
- 5.2 If the Constructing Authority pulls down or breaks open any fencing under this easement:
 - (a) the Constructing Authority may either repair the fencing it has pulled down or broken open or install a gate in place of that fencing to at least a standard reasonably equivalent to that of the fencing before it was pulled down or broken open;
 - (b) the owner of the fencing that was pulled down or broken open will become the owner of the repaired fencing or gate; and

(c) that owner must maintain the repaired fencing or gate.

5.3 The Registered Owner must do all things reasonably required by the Constructing Authority from time to time in order to make sure that the Constructing Authority is given all the rights and powers intended to be conferred by this easement.

2.2 Sewerage or Water Supply or Both

Where the purpose of this Easement includes Sewerage or Water Supply or both the following will apply

The Owner grants Unitywater the full and free right and liberty at all times, after the date of this Easement, to enter upon the Easement Land for the purposes of constructing and thereafter forever using and maintaining the Relevant Works as it shall from time to time think fit and in so doing, Unitywater by its employees, agents and other persons authorised by Unitywater has the right to:

- (a) construct, install, extend, deepen, widen, cleanse, add to, remove, inspect, maintain and repair the Relevant Works and when and where thought fit by Unitywater to remove and replace the Relevant Works with new Relevant Works (whether of a similar nature to those replaced or not);

- (c) dig into, sink shafts in, and erect scaffolding upon the Easement Land and to open and break up the soil of the Easement Land or any part of the Easement Land including its sub-surface;
- (d) remove and dispose of spoil created as a consequence of exercising its rights hereunder;
- (e) clear and keep clear the Easement Land by any means or method and to cut and remove timber, trees and undergrowth from the Easement Land and to burn off such timber, trees and undergrowth;
- (f) construct and maintain on the Easement Land such access tracks, gates and appurtenant works as it considers necessary;
- (g) enter upon and remain, pass and repass on and over the Easement Land for all or any of the purposes aforesaid with or without vehicles, plant and equipment of any description whatsoever;
- (h) enter and exit to and from the Easement Land over such part or parts of the Owner's land adjoining or adjacent to the Easement Land as is reasonably required by Unitywater and Unitywater shall consider most convenient or necessary for the purpose of passing between the Easement Land and the most convenient

point of entry to or exit from the Owner's land (whether adjoining a constructed road or not);

- do such other works and things through, across, in or under the Easement Land as are incidental to the proper exercise of the rights granted to Unitywater under this Easement; and
- (j) use such part or parts of the Owner's land immediately adjacent to or adjoining either side of the Easement Land as may be reasonably required by Unitywater for the proper exercise of the rights granted to Unitywater under this Easement.

3. PROPERTY IN RELEVANT WORKS

The Relevant Works are and remain the property of Unitywater notwithstanding any actual or apparent affixing to the Easement Land. Unitywater shall be solely responsible, for the operation and maintenance of all Relevant Works.

4. FENCING

4.1 Removal

For the purpose of gaining access to the Easement Land, Unitywater may demolish or break open any fencing on or adjacent to the Easement Land. However, if livestock are contained within the fenced area, Unitywater must give reasonable notice to the Owner to enable the Owner to secure the livestock.

4.2 Reinstatement

Unitywater must either:

- (a) reinstate all fences (other than a fence erected in contravention of Clause 5) damaged by Unitywater in the exercise and performance of any of the rights and liberties granted to Unitywater under this Easement; or
- (b) if the fences are not reinstated, install a gate using materials and employing workmanship which is not less than the quality of the materials and workmanship in the existing fence. The gate installed pursuant to this subclause becomes the property of the owner of the fence in which the gate is installed and after installation shall be maintained by the owner.

5. NO STRUCTURES ON THE EASEMENT LAND

The Owner must not at any time without the express written permission of Unitywater (which must not be unreasonably withheld):

- (a) erect any buildings or structures (other than fences) upon the Easement Land or any part of it;
- (b) permit the Easement Land or any part of it to be used in such a way as to obstruct or interfere with the Relevant Works and/or the proper and effective use of the Relevant Works by Unitywater;
- (c) install concrete, bitumen or other pavement or driveways (except residential driveways) on the Easement Land or gardens or landscaping involving concrete, brick or other permanent materials; or
- (d) remove or stockpile or permit the removal or stockpiling of any soil, sand, gravel or other substance or material on the Easement Land or construct any roads, dam walls or other earthworks on the Easement Land which would in any way obstruct or interfere with the Relevant Works and/or the proper and effective use of the Relevant Works by Unitywater.

6. DAMAGE TO STRUCTURES

- (a) Unitywater acting reasonably at all times and complying with all relevant laws, will determine how and in what manner the rights granted to Unitywater under this Easement are exercised.
- (b) Unitywater must not wilfully damage or destroy any Matter to any extent greater than is reasonably

necessary in order to exercise its rights under this Easement but:

- Unitywater is not otherwise responsible for any damage to or destruction of any Matter in the course of the exercise by Unitywater of its rights under this Easement; and
- (ii) subject to Clause 4, Unitywater is not under any obligation to reinstate or repair any Matter damaged or destroyed in consequence of the exercise by Unitywater of its rights under this Easement and its only obligation where such Matter has been so damaged or destroyed is to leave the Easement Land in as clean and tidy state as practicable having regard to the nature of the Matter which has been damaged or destroyed and the work which it has done; and
- (iii) Unitywater is not in any event responsible for any inconvenience or disturbance to the Owner or occupiers of the Easement Land arising out of the exercise by Unitywater of its rights under this Easement.

7. REMOVAL OF UNAUTHORISED STRUCTURES

- If a Matter is erected, placed, found or installed upon the Easement Land in contravention of Clause 5, Unitywater may, in addition to any other remedies and after having first given the Owner reasonable notice of its intention to invoke this clause, enter upon the Easement Land and remove or demolish the Matter and, if it does so:
 - (a) it may dispose of the Matter or any resultant demolition materials in such manner as it sees fit without being liable to account to the Owner therefore (except as provided in subclause (b) of this clause); and
 - (b) it may recover, in any Court of competent jurisdiction, costs actually incurred by it in taking that action (including internal wage and salary costs) less any moneys actually received by it as a result of disposing of the Matter or any resultant demolition materials.

8. PROTECTION OF RELEVANT WORKS

The Owner will not do any act or make any omission which will jeopardise or prejudicially affect the safety or reliable working of any Relevant Works.

9. RATES AND CHARGES

The Owner is responsible for all local authority rates and assessments and lawful charges in relation to the Easement Land.

10. FURTHER ASSURANCES

The benefit and burden of this Easement shall pass with and bind the Easement Land so as to enure to and bind all persons deriving title thereto from and under the Owner and Unitywater respectively and the Owner, whenever required by Unitywater or the person or persons for the time being entitled to the benefit of this Easement, must do all such things and give all such assurances as are reasonably required for the proper and effective carrying into effect of the rights conferred under this Easement but not so as to render the Owner liable to be called upon to contribute towards the maintenance and upkeep of the Relevant Works.

11. SPECIAL COVENANTS FOR STATE RESERVE LAND

- (a) The following clauses are in addition to or replace where noted those set out above and will form part of the covenants of this Easement when any land is designated as a "Reserve" in accordance with the Land Act 1994 (as amended from time to time).
- (b) In this clause:

"Minister" means the Minister administering the *Land Act 1994* (as amended from time to time); and "Trustee" means the relevant Trustee of the State Reserved Land.

(c) Reinstatement of fencing

Clause 4.2 of this Easement is deleted and replaced with the following:

Unitywater must either:

- (a) Reinstate all fences damaged by it in the exercise of any of its rights granted herein; and
- (b) In lieu of reinstating any such fence, install a gate the quality and materials of workmanship of which must be not less than the quality and materials of workmanship of the existing fence.

(d) Removal of Unauthorised structures etc

Clause 7 of this Easement is omitted and replaced with the following:

If anything is erected, placed, found or installed upon the Easement Land in contravention of Clause 5, Unitywater may, in addition to any other remedies, and having given the Owner reasonable notice of its intention to invoke this clause, enter Easement Land and remove or demolish the Matter. If it does so it may dispose of the Matter or any resultant demolition materials in such manner as it sees fit without being liable.

(e) *Removal of Trees*

Unitywater must not cut or remove timber or tress from the Easement Land without first giving reasonable notice to the Owner and obtaining all necessary permits. Such notice will not be required under this clause in the event that there is an actual or potential danger to persons or property or there is any interference or jeopardy to the supply of the Relevant Works.

(f) Removal of Assets upon termination of easement Under the Land Act 1994, an easement over a reserve ends when the dedication of reserve is revoked unless a written approval is provided by the Minister that the easement may continue over unallocated State Land when the dedication of reserve is revoked.

Upon termination of the Easement, Unitywater

- (i.) must ensure that the Easement Land is left in a safe and stable condition to the satisfaction of the Minister; and
- (ii.) will unless directed by the Minister otherwise, at its own cost and expense, remove all of the Relevant Works from the Easement Land; and
- (iii.) will remove, at its own cost and expense, all of the Relevant Works from the Easement Land that may cause contamination or environmental harm to the Easement Land as defined by the *Environmental Protection Act* 1994 or similar legislation.

(g) Indemnity and Risk

The following clauses will apply for the duration of the Easement and will continue to apply during the periods of rehabilitation and any removal of the Relevant Works under clause 11 (f):

(i.) Indemnity

a. Unitywater indemnifies and agrees to keep indemnified the Minister, the State of Queensland, Trustee and

Owner (the "indemnified parties") against all actions, suits, proceedings, claims, demands, costs, losses, damages and expenses ("Claims") arising out of or in any way connected to or resulting from the granting of this Easement to Unitywater or which is connected to or resulting from Unitywater's use and occupation of the Easement Land (all of which are referred to as "the indemnified acts or omissions") save to the extent that the claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the indemnified parties, however, any negligent act or omission or one of the indemnified parties does not negate the indemnity to any other indemnified parties.

b. Unitywater hereby releases and discharges the indemnified parties from any Claim relating to the indemnified acts or omissions which may be made against the indemnified parties, save to the extent that the Claim arises as a result of any negligent act or omission of the indemnified parties, however, any negligent act or omission of one of the indemnified parties does not negate the release and discharge in favour of any of the other indemnified parties.

(ii.) Public Risk

a.

- Unitywater must effect a public liability insurance policy with an insurer authorised under the Insurance Act 1973 (Commonwealth) or. in any other case, to the satisfaction of the Minister naming Unitywater as the insured covering legal liability for any loss of, or damage to any property and for the injury (including death) to any person arising out of anything done or omitted on or about the easement land or any improvements thereon and against all claims, demands. proceedings, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect thereof subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance policy.
- b. Such policy must:
 - (a) be for an amount not less than \$20,000,000.00 (Twenty Million dollars) in respect of all claims arising out of a single event or such higher amounts as the Minister may reasonably require; and
 - (b) be effected on a "claims occurring" basis so that any claim made by Unitywater under the policy after expiration of the period of policy cover but relating to an event occurring during the currency of the policy will be covered by the policy subject to the claim meeting the policy's other terms and conditions; and
 - (c) be maintained at all times during the currency of the Easement,

and upon receipt of any Notice of Cancellation, Unitywater must immediately effect another public liability insurance policy in accordance with the provisions of this Clause 11(g) (ii.).

- c. Unitywater must also provide a certificate of currency within 14 days of a request by the Owner who may only make such request once a year.
- d. Unitywater must, as soon as practicable, inform the Minister and Owner in writing, of the occurrence of any event that Unitywater considers is likely to give rise to a claim under the policy of insurance effected and must ensure that the Minter and Owner are kept fully informed of subsequent actions and developments concerning the claim.

(h) Power of Attorney

Whilst the Easement Land remains unallocated State Land or is dedicated as a Reserve pursuant to the *Land Act 1994* as amended from time to time or is registered solely in the name of the State of Queensland, Unitywater irrevocably appoints in so far as it is legally able to the State of Queensland the true and lawful attorney of Unitywater enabling the attorney to do all such things as the attorney may consider necessary or desirable to effect a surrender of this easement upon the default by Unitywater of any condition, covenant or clause of this easement provided however that the State of Queensland may only exercise its right to surrender the easement under this clause if:

- (i.) Unitywater has breached a condition, covenant or clause of this easement; and
- (ii.) the State of Queensland has given written notice to the breach of Unitywater; and
- (iii.) the State of Queensland has allowed Unitywater 90 days from the date of receipt of the notice to remedy the breach, and
- (iv.) Unitywater has not remedied the breach by the expiration of that 90 days.
