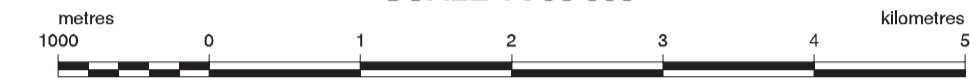


# CURRENT LAND USE (1995)
