That on and from 7 October 2011, the declaration of the State-controlled road specified in Appendix I hereto, be revoked, and in lieu thereof, the road described in Appendix II hereto, be declared a State-controlled road, respectively, under and for the purposes of the *Transport Infrastructure Act* 1994.

The area (that is, alignment and width) of the State-controlled road described in Appendix II shall apply to the full width of the road corridor, where the existing trafficked route is contained within a surveyed road corridor, provided that, where the existing trafficked route is contained within a State reserve, State forest, timber reserve, vacant State land or pastoral holding, the area (that is, alignment and width) shall apply to 30 metres each side of the centre line of the trafficked route.

1. Short Title

This Notice may be cited as the *Members' Entitlements Handbook Amendment Notice (No. 1) 2011*.

Amendment of Schedule A - Salary Payable to Members of the Queensland Legislative Assembly

Schedule A of the *Members' Entitlements Handbook* (the Handbook) shall be amended to insert the Chairperson and Members of the Committee of the Legislative Assembly; Finance and Administration Committee; Legal Affairs, Police, Corrective Services and Emergency Services Committee; Industry, Education, Training and Industrial Relations Committee; Environment, Agriculture, Resources and Energy Committee; Community Affairs Committee; Health and Disabilities Committee; Transport, Local Government and Infrastructure Committee; and the Ethics Committee in the list of Office Holders of the Queensland Legislative Assembly that attract an additional salary, and to omit all references to the Scrutiny of Legislation Committee; Public Accounts and Public Works Committee; Economic Development Committee; Environment and Resources Committee; Social Development Committee; Law, Justice and Safety Committee; Review of the Parliamentary Committee System Committee; and the Integrity, Ethics and Parliamentary Privileges Committee.

3. Parliamentary Secretary and Leader of the House

From 10 March 2011, the rate of additional salary payable to the Parliamentary Secretary and Leader of the House, as outlined in Schedule A of the Handbook, is increased by \$15,652 per annum.

From 16 June 2011, the rate of additional salary payable to the Parliamentary Secretary and Leader of the House, as outlined in Schedule A of the Handbook, is increased by \$5,000 per annum.

4. Manager of Opposition Business

From 10 March 2011, an additional salary of \$15,652 per annum is to apply to the position of Manager of Opposition Business and the office of Manager of Opposition Business is to be inserted into Schedule A, together with the rate of additional salary payable to the office.

From 16 June 2011, the rate of additional salary payable to the Manager of Opposition Business, as outlined in Schedule A of the Handbook, is increased to \$20,652 per annum.

5. Chairpersons of Parliamentary Committees

From 16 June 2011, the rate of additional salary payable to a chairperson of a parliamentary committee to which an additional salary is payable, is increased by \$5,000 per annum.

6. Annual CPI increase

The Handbook provides that certain allowances are to be varied annually from 1 July in accordance with the variation in the Consumer Price Index for Brisbane over the previous financial year.

The Consumer Price Index for Brisbane rose by 3.8% for the financial year ending 30 June 2011.

As from 1 July 2011, the rates outlined within Schedule B of the Handbook, 'Allowance to Members of the Queensland Legislative Assembly', and Schedule C of the Handbook, 'Other Variable Allowances,'Allocations Payable to Members of the Queensland Legislative Assembly' (Miscellaneous Allowance, General Travel Allocation, Daily Travel Allowance (Domestic), Daily Travel Allowance (Overseas), Special Car Allowance and Flight Within Electorate Allocation), are increased by 3.8%.


