In this Direction these terms have the following meanings:

- (1) Under 10(g) of the Act, I direct the Authority to investigate and provide a report on the pipeline, in accordance with the requirements of this direction.
- (2) The Authority should investigate and report on options for recovering the costs of the pipeline, taking into account the following objectives:
 - (a) recovery of capital and operating costs from all customers over the life of the pipeline
 - (b) maintaining affordable water prices for all customers

- (c) a sustainable financial position for the local councils
 - (d) a sustainable financial position for the GAWB, as the pipeline's main proponent
 - (e) leveraging GAWB's financial capacity to self-fund the pipeline
 - (f) minimising the need for government contributions and subsidies.
- (3) The Authority's report should also give consideration to the following:
- (a) the regulatory arrangements that should apply to the pipeline, including:
 - (i) the two potential operational phases of the pipeline (i.e. uni-directional and bi-directional)
 - (ii) appropriate transitional arrangements
 - (iii) any recommendations for necessary changes to legislation consequential to the outcomes of the investigation
 - (b) measures to manage the price impact on customers, such as smoothing price increases over time or limiting the amount of capital recovery from customers
 - (c) promoting the maintenance of the accounting asset value of the pipeline throughout its lifecycle and varying usage levels
 - (d) mechanisms to promote full cost recovery as usage of the pipeline changes over time.

Conduct of the Authority

- (4) The Authority may exercise the powers under Part 6, Division 5 of the Act in undertaking the investigation.
- (5) The Authority must provide to the Minister:
 - (a) a draft report no later than 30 September 2022
 - (b) a final report no later than 30 November 2022.
