

Toowoomba catchment area

The Toowoomba catchment includes the Toowoomba North Child Safety Service Centre and the Toowoomba South Child Safety Service Centre.

Toowoomba catchment profile

On 30 June 2012, it was estimated there were 239,220 people residing within the Toowoomba catchment area. This represented approximately 5% of the estimated resident population of Queensland (4,565,529 people). The estimated number of children aged 0-17 years was 61,638 people (approximately 6% of the Queensland population of children aged 0-17 years).

The population of people who identified as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander in Toowoomba as at 30 June 2012 was 8,115 (3.5% of the total population in the catchment). In Queensland, the population of people who identified as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander was 155,824 (3.6% of the total population).
