Notice is given under the  $\mathit{Sustainable Planning Act 2009}$  that on 29 November 2016 the Council of the City of Gold Coast resolved to repeal the Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 2 (Party houses) 2016, effective 2 February 2017. The purpose and general effect of the resolution is to confirm the expiry of the Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 2 (Party houses) 2016 and align with the commencement of a replacement Temporary Local Planning Instrument.

Notice is given under the Sustainable Planning Act 2009 that on 29 November 2016 the Council of the City of Gold Coast adopted the Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017 for the City of Gold Coast.

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017 will take effect on 2 February 2017 and cease to have effect on 1 February 2018 unless repealed sooner. The Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017 has retrospective effect.

The purpose and general effect of the *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017* is to enable the regulation of party house land uses by:

- identifying all of the planning scheme area as a party house restriction area; and
- affecting the operation of the planning scheme by making material change of use for a party house impact assessable and applying assessment provisions for development applications for material change of use for a party house.

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017 overrides specified provisions of the Gold Coast City Plan.
